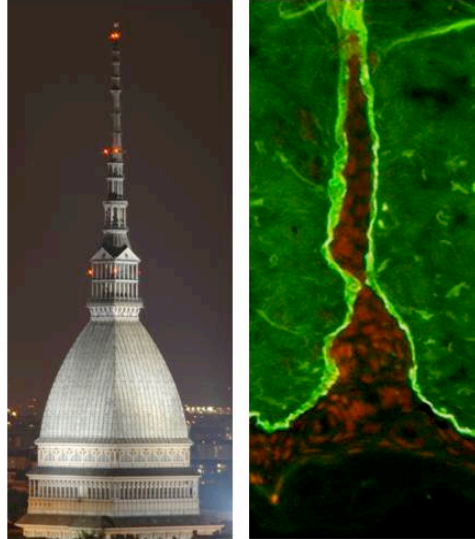


DERMATOPATHOLOGY WORKSHOP FOR BEGINNERS INFLAMMATORY SKIN DISEASES 'STEP BY STEP'



**13-14 November, 2015
Turin, Italy**

General Information

Under the auspices of the Italian Association of Dermatopathology (AIDEPAT), the Italian Society of Dermatology and Sexually Transmitted Diseases (SIDEMaST), the Italian Association of Hospital Dermatologists (ADOI) and the European Society of Dermatopathology (ESDP), we are pleased to announce **PART 1** of our newly devised Course: '**Step by Step**': **Dermatopathology Workshop for Beginners**. **PART 1** is a two-day intensive theoretical-practical course focused on inflammatory skin diseases. **PART 2** (date to be announced) will be focused on skin tumors.

Course Description

This course is designed particularly for trainees in dermatology and pathology as well as junior consultants who wish to enhance their basic knowledge of dermatopathology. The course will be held as an interactive workshop with PowerPoint lectures, case discussions and with slide viewing with screen projection.

Course Structure

- A) **Theoretical session** (morning): lectures where the participants will receive a stepwise comprehensive exposure to the basic principles of dermatopathology and will be introduced in a "step by step" manner to the learning of the main inflammatory patterns of skin disease
- B) **Practical session** (afternoon): screen projection of slides and immunofluorescence cases where participants will have a guided access and direct study with the Faculty of selected pathologic slides relative to the topics presented in the theoretical session. Special emphasis will be given to clinical-pathological correlation and to the understanding of the value of integrating dermatopathology in clinical practice
- C) **Self-assessment** (concluding the course): multiple choice questions with interactive discussion.

Course Objectives:

The participant is expected to:

1. Increase their knowledge of basic dermatopathology
2. Enhance their overall diagnostic skills
3. Understand the value of clinical-pathological correlation
4. Improve their interpretation of a dermatopathology report and enhance communication between dermatologists and pathologists/dermatopathologists
